

## Danggali Conservation Park

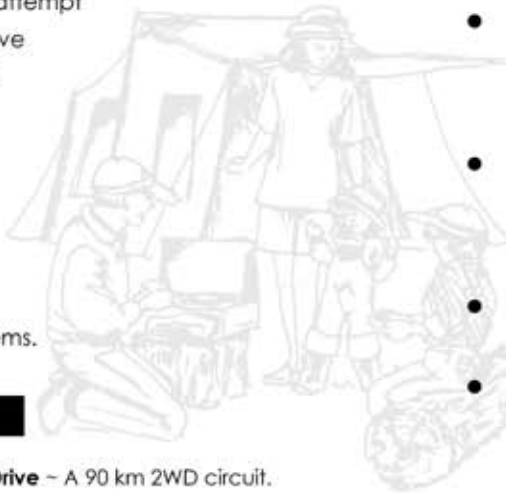


**Location:** 350 km (4.5 hours) NE of Adelaide, 90km north of Renmark, via the Sturt Highway, off Old Wentworth Rd.

**Size:** 253 660 hectares

Danggali Conservation Park is known for its vastness and wilderness appeal. It is dominated by mallee scrubland and in 1977 was classified as Australia's first Biosphere Reserve under UNESCO's 'Man and the Biosphere Program'. This is an international attempt to protect representative samples of ecosystems throughout the world.

The ecosystem in Danggali is the ecotone, or overlap, between the mallee and the arid land-systems.



### REMINDERS

- Water supplies are severely limited.
- The best time to visit the park is between April and October.
- No food or fuel is available in the park.
- Plan your trip. The remoteness of the park and lack of water requires visitors' to be prepared to cope with isolated conditions.
- Contact the resident Park Ranger prior to travelling (08) 8595 8010.
- Bookings for the Shearer's Quarters are essential, for costs and booking information contact the resident Park Ranger or District Office.
- Camping permits are required to stay in the park. Permits are available from the Danggali Park Office, Berri District Office and selected Riverland tourist centres.
- During fire ban season only gas fires are permitted and fire restrictions must be observed.
- Pets are not permitted in the park.

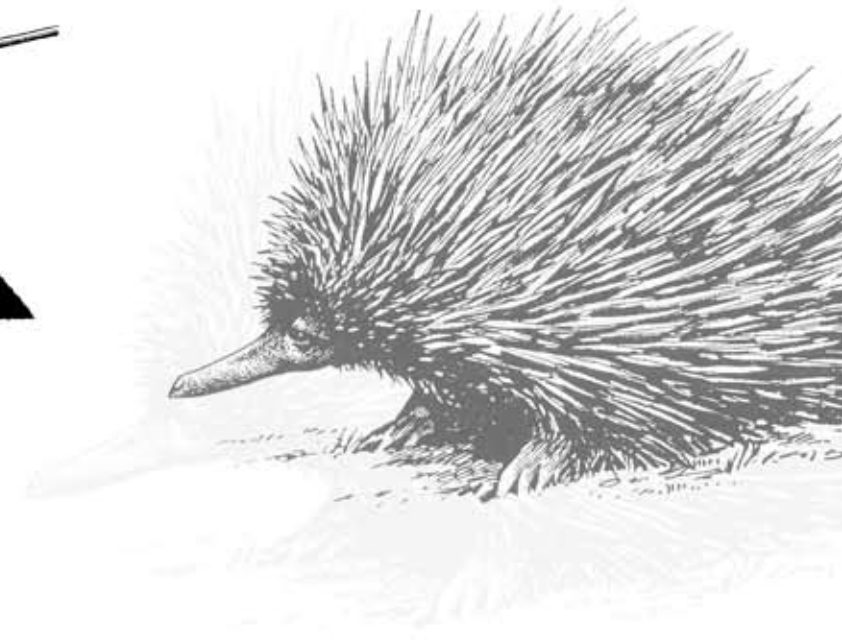

- **Tipperary Drive** - A 100 km 4WD tour.

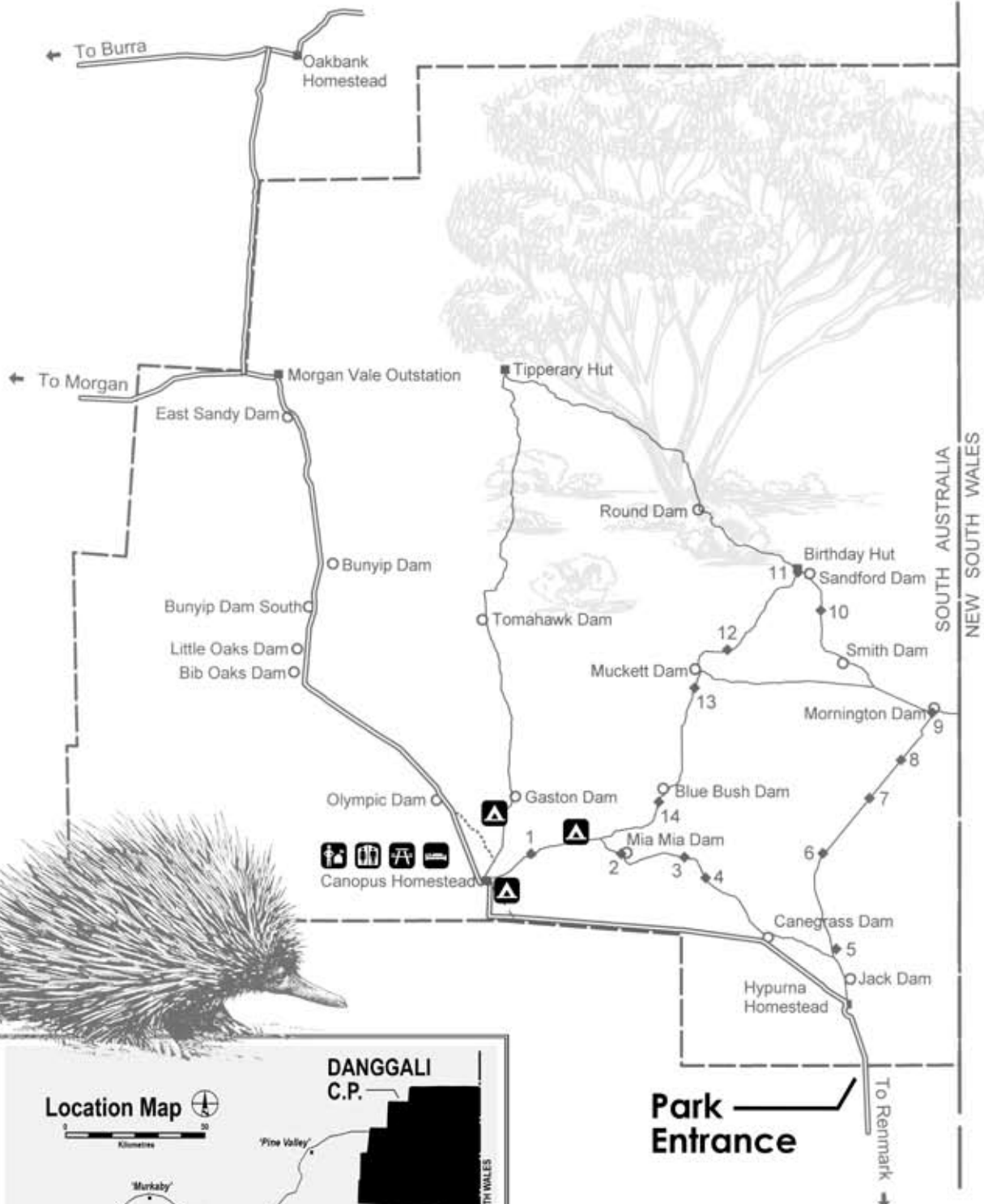


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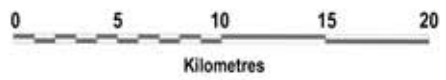
